Before You Donate:

Check Lists: Review our lists of Items We Generally Accept and Items We Are Currently NOT Accepting to ensure your items align with our needs.

Organize Items: You can help us by organizing items clearly. Bag similar items together (e.g., corks, bottle caps). Well-organized donations speed up the process.

Packaging: Bring your donation in a bag, box, or container that can be left behind. We reserve the right to refuse disorganized or oversized donations.

How to Donate:

Drop-Off Location: Donations are accepted at the rear of our building, during Open Studio hours, accessible through the Employee and Accessible Entrance – located just off the parking lot.

Please DON'T Dump: Kindly refrain from leaving donations outside our building during non-operating hours.

During Donation:

Parking: Park in the Maxtivity lot or along 16th Street. Donations typically take 5-15 minutes.

Wait Time: Be prepared for a brief wait as staff assists other donors or Open Studio participants. We'll go through your donation, sorting it into general categories. Your assistance in the sorting process may be requested.

Weight Limit: Donations over 60 lbs. may need to be split over multiple days or scheduled with our staff.

Tax Receipts: Upon request, tax receipts are provided for your generous donations.
